ITEM BACKGROUND

The America250 Art Installation and Activation is a collaborative public art initiative developed by the City of Roswell in partnership with Dashboard, Inc., as part of *Roswell, Georgia's America 250: Tapestry of Generations* celebration in 2026. Dashboard, Inc is a creative-based non-profit producing transformative arts experiences in public spaces. The City previously partnered with Dashboard, Inc. in 2018 for a successful public art installation at Historic Town Square.

Throughout 2025, this community-wide initiative invited residents and visitors to create tapestry-inspired artwork reflecting personal stories, shared heritage, and community identity through a series of professional, artist-led workshops at multiple City events. These individual works will be conceptually unified and inspire a singular, temporary public art piece to be installed at Heart of Roswell Park. The completed installation will be unveiled to the public during a reception on National Quilt Day, March 21, 2026, celebrating Roswell's diverse voices and collective history.

The initiative is further amplified through a coordinated cultural activation at the Roswell Cultural Arts Center, including a staged production of *Quilters* and a companion exhibit featuring selected community artworks. The musical, which honors the lives and stories of frontier women through music and storytelling, provides a natural thematic extension of the community-created installation and reinforces the broader goals of the America 250 celebration—connecting past and present through shared stories, creativity, and place.
